GUIDELINES FOR Ph.D. COURSE WORK

(Effective from 1st August 2018)

Ph.D. course work shall consist of 3 papers as follows:

1. Paper-I

Title : **Contemporary issues**

Maximum Marks : 150

Duration : 1st August to 30th November

Required working hours : 250 (minimum 75% attendance to be verified by the Supervisor).

The Departmental Committee shall allot one topic to each candidate which is of contemporary relevance, in consultation with the Supervisor, related with the area of interest of the candidate.

The candidate shall be required to prepare a detailed Term Paper on the topic, under the guidance of the Supervisor. This shall be submitted by the candidate duly forwarded by the Supervisor.

2. Paper-II

Title : **Review of Literature**

Maximum Marks: 150

Duration : 1st January to 30th April.

Required working hours : 250 (Minimum 75% attendance to be verified by the Supervisor)

The Review of Literature submitted by the candidate should be substantial and justify semester long work.

The review should be submitted covering minimum 50 pages. This shall be forwarded by the Supervisor verifying attendance of the candidate and counter-signed by the Head of the Department.

3. Paper-III

Title : **Research Methodology and Information & Communication Technology**

Maximum Marks : 200

Duration : 1st May to 20th June.

Classes/workshops shall be held for 5 hours a day from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on all working days. After completion of the classes/workshops, there shall be theory examination of Research Methodology and practical examination of ICT.


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
